HEALTH TECHNOLOGY

Health Technician, serves in a more entry-level role and perform tasks that include running routine tests, inputting patient data, setting up equipment, preparing patients for procedures, and administering medication. To become a health technician and earn a diploma you will need to complete a two-year course in respective program.





SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY

• Surgical technologists, more commonly known as surgical technician being the part of surgical team assist surgeons and other medical personnel before, during, and after operational procedures. They are trained individuals who often hold advance certifications and key member of the surgical team.





ANESTHESIA TECHNOLOGY

Anesthesia technology is an allied health profession precisely focused on fundamental and advanced clinical procedures which assist the anesthetist in the safe and effective care of patients. Applicant desiring to be a Certified Anesthesia Technologist must attend an approved or an accredited educational program.





DENTAL TECHNOLOGY

A dental technician who passes the certification examination becomes a Certified Dental Technician (CDT) Dental Technician or Dental Technologist specializes in one or more of six areas: implants, complete dentures, removable partial dentures, crown and bridge, ceramics or orthodontics. The duration of this course is 2 years to complete.





LABORATORY TECHNOLOGY

Lab technician is skilled at laboratory science and carry out tests on blood, body fluids, or skin samples to check for the presence of disease. Lab technicians must be familiar with using equipment like microscopes and chromatographs, and they must further understand the application of various chemicals or agents in order to yield test results. A lab technician in a lab may be trained in phlebotomy, the collection of blood, in addition to being trained in the analysis of various samples.





PHARMACY CATEGORY-B

The NICE Education System offers 2 years pharmacy Category "B" program that enables individual to Perform different pharmacy related functions. After passing two years exams, qualified is eligible for a join in public sector of grade 14 in Pakistan, and can get a license to open medical store in any area of Pakistan.

ADMISSION POLICY:

A candidate seeking admission in any of the program available in NICE Education System shall apply on a prescribed form available on www.niceeducationsystem.edu.pk/ appended in the prospectus. Candidate shall submit the application form before the deadline along with attested photocopies of all the required necessary documents mentioned in the application form.

If any document/information provided by the candidate is found false/fake or fabricated at any stage of the course admission will be cancelled. Incomplete application forms will be rejected. Both male and female eligible candidates can apply Nursing Program available in NICE College of Nursing Peshawar.

HEALTH:

Candidates will be acquired to complete a health questionnaire and acceptance in the program will only be granted if satisfactory health clearance is obtained.

CRIMINAL CONVICTION:

Candidates will be asked to sign a declaration form about any past criminal conviction and will have to give written consent allowing us to check a police record. Candidates will not automatically be barred from entering the nursing profession if having a criminal conviction or caution. The college will take into account the circumstances surrounding the case and will treat any information in the strictest of confidentiality.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

Final merit list will be based on Entrance test, interview and eligibility criteria as recommended by respective Councils/Faculties.



FOR POST RN (2 years Program)

Merit will be calculated as below:

1. Cumulative percentage of all the diploma examinations including midwifery.

2. Percentage marks in entry test.

3. One mark per year of the professional experience in a recognized institution up to a maximum of 05 marks.

BS Nursing (4 years Program)

Admission will be open to candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary Certificate Examination (F.Sc. Pre-medical) or possessing an equivalent qualification from a recognized board with minimum of 50% marks. The merit for admission will be determined as follows.

FOR MALE STUDENTS:

a. The students will wear grey dress pant, white dress shirt, black shoes, and white overall and display their ID cards in the college

b. In winter students will wear dark blue sweater/jersey/coat

c. Tight jeans and shirts containing logos/mark are not allowed.

•Bribing or coercing another person to obtain an administered test or obtain information about an un-administered test or other academic products.

•Purchasing or otherwise acquiring and submitting as one's own work, any research paper or other assignment prepared by another individual or by a firm.

•Submitting the same essay, thesis, report or another project, without substantial revisionor expansion of the work, in an attempt to obtain credit for work submitted in another course.

•Falsifying data.



Students will refrain from any behaviour which can be interpreted by others as sexual harassment.

• Student will obtain written authorization before making public statements, communicationor correspondence with the press or other media for mass communication on behalf of the institute.

e) Suspension from the institute or expulsion from the institute residences if so required.

f) Any other penalty which the institute may deem fit to impose.



Academic Penalties:

Students may receive one or more of the following sanctions for academic honesty violations:

• Requirement to perform additional academic work not required of other students in the course.

Reduction in grade in the course to any level.

• Reduction in grade on an examination, or on other academic work affected by the violation of the Honor Code.

General Conduct:

All students will present themselves with dignity befitting their status as mature, professional and responsible citizens.

•Students in all settings on campus are expected to dress in a simple and decent manner.

•Students individually or as a group, will obtained written University approval before organizing or assisting in organizing

demonstrations, rallies or picketing on campus.

• Students individually or as a group will refrain from disseminating or causing to disseminate materials or engage in any activity

which hinder or prevent the full participation of another person or group in the life of the institute. • All political, ethnic, religious and social activities held in the campus must have prior written institute authorization.

•Students will ensure that their actions do not endanger or threaten the health, safety or wellbeing of other person.
